Short-term scientific missions and conference grants in OMEGA-NET

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Short-term scientific missions (STSM)

- STSM: exchange visits between researchers involved in a COST Action, allowing scientists to visit an institution in another COST country; aimed at fostering collaboration, sharing techniques and infrastructure.
- Eligibility: applicants must be engaged in an official research programme as a PhD Student or postdoctoral fellow or can be employed by, or affiliated to, an institution, organisation or legal entity which has within its remit a clear association with performing research.
- Evaluation: must consider the <u>scientific scope of the proposed mission</u> and how the mission can <u>support the Action in achieving its scientific objectives</u>.

STSM criteria

- Duration: 5-90 calendar days; additional option of 91-180 days for early career investigators (ECI, i.e. up to 8 years from PhD completion)
 - Typically I-2 weeks duration in previous Actions
- Carried out in their entirety within a single Grant Period and always within the Action's lifetime

 STSM grantees must make their own arrangements for all provisions related to personal security, health, taxation, social security and pension matters.

STSM financial support and payment

• Fixed financial contribution which considers the budget request and the outcome of the evaluation. Does not necessarily cover all expenses related to undertaking a given mission.

Amounts:

- Up to EUR 2 500 in total to each successful applicant (EUR 3 500 for ECI missions between 91-180 days);
- Up to EUR 160 per day for accommodation and meal expenses.
- 30 calendar days from the end date of the mission to submit a scientific report to the STSM Committee and the Host institution. Payment of the Grant is subject to the scientific report being approved in writing.

STSM in OMEGA-NET

Applicants should:

- contact the potential host with a demonstration of interest;
- with support from the host, fill in the preapproval questionnaire summarising the objectives and context of the mission and email it to the STSM coordinator (Raquel Lucas: rlucas@med.up.pt) copying the Action Chair (Ingrid S. Mehlum: ingrid.s.mehlum@stami.no);



Conference grants for ITC

- New tool to help PhD students and ECIs from participating Inclusiveness Target Countries (ITC) attend international science and technology related conferences that are not organised by a COST Action.
- Applicant must present work on the topic of the Action and be listed in the programme.
- Any e-COST user who is a PhD student or an ECI and is affiliated with an institution located in an ITC country participating in the Action can submit an application for an Conference Grant, at least 45 days before the conference start date. The applicant must be engaged in an official research programme as a PhD Student or postdoctoral fellow.

ITC: Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, FYR Macedonia, Republic of Serbia and Turkey.

 Fixed financial contribution which considers the budget request and the outcome of the evaluation. Does not necessarily cover all expenses related to conference participation.


Amounts:

- Up to EUR 2 500 in total to each successful applicant;
- Up to EUR 160 per day for accommodation and meal expenses;
- Up to EUR 500 for conference fees
- 30 calendar days from the end date of the mission to submit a scientific report. Payment of the grant is subject to the scientific report being approved in writing.
